- 1. Find a shoebox. Pack it with fun toys, supplies, and gifts. (Please see attached flier for a shoebox checklist, tracking label, and gift ideas)
- 2. Deliver it to the school between now and November 15<sup>th</sup>! Boxes will be collected and delivered to a drop off location on Thursday November 15<sup>th</sup>.
- 3. Make a monetary donation to help towards shipping the boxes. **The cost to ship a box is \$9.** All money collected will be given to Operation Christmas Child, and we will be able to track the shipment of our school's boxes around the world! Please include a check made payable to Operation Christmas Child or if you send in cash you can put in an envelope with Operation Christmas Child on the outside.
- 4. THE CLASS WITH THE MOST BOXES WILL RECEIVE THEIR VERY OWN RECESS BAG!!!!!

Please deliver your shoebox to your classroom so we can keep up with the classroom totals. Our goal is to collect 100 boxes this year!!!!! Would you prayerfully consider how you can be a part of this initiative? THANK YOU!!!

## Shoebox packing checklist

Pleas	e try to include age appropriate items from every category in your box:
	Hygiene items (toothbrush, comb, washcloth, bar soap) NO LIQUIDS!
	School items (paper, pencils, crayons, pens, markers, notepads)
	Accessories (hair bows, bracelets, sunglasses, hat, foldable bag)
	Toys (jump rope, small ball, toy cars, legos, deflated soccer ball w/ pump
	One game (puzzles, playing cards)
	One stuffed animal or doll
	Clothing (socks, tshirts, dress, underwear, shorts, flip flops)

Fill any remaining space with additional toys, school items, and accessories.

Finish your box by including a note and praying for the child who will receive your box.

Cut out and complete the packing label below and tape it to your box. For multiple boxes, print copies of the same packing label and attach them to your box. Thank you!



## Do Not Include

Candy; toothpaste; gum; used or damaged items; war-related items such as toy guns, knives, or military figures; chocolate or food; seeds; fruit rolls or other fruit snacks; drink mixes (powdered or liquid); liquids or lotions; medications or vitamins; breakable items such as snow globes or glass containers; aerosol cans.
